Tim Westerman-Loe reports that he ran the Sarsen Trail Neolithic marathon on Sunday in incredibly unpleasant conditions across Salisbury plain. It was from Avebury circle to Stonehenge, complete with marathon runners, walkers, mountain bikers and a half marathon. The weather was not good so the promised spectacular views did not emerge from a blanket of grey cloud and the tracks were nicely churned up due to the earlier starting walkers. At times it was like I was running backwards but I was pleased to knock a massive one and a half minutes off my only other marathon time to finish in 3.47.32! (although this is not an official time).

Also last weekend, 24th and 25th April, along with two friends and competing under the name Mid Life Crisis he took part in a two day Adventure race called Q2 The Quest Challenge. Saturday was a two and a half hour run followed by a three hour mountain bike stage, which included half an hour kayaking in Poole harbour, and topped off with a nice little night run of just over an hour. Sunday was a straightforward four hours of competition where they could pick how much time was spent running or mountain biking - but still with a nice little paddle around the harbour thrown in. The general idea was to gather as many points as possible by mapping routes around the Purbecks to visit as many checkpoints as possible in the time available. There were also compulsory checkpoints to visit with extra points available if you could solve different puzzles. They came 9th out of 21 teams in the Novice Trio race and 11th overall from nearly 50 teams in the Novice category. It was a superb weekend, with fantastic weather, great organisation and a very friendly atmosphere. They're ready to sign up again for next year as soon as the dates are posted and will definitely be competing in these types of events more often. Brilliant!
